**ORDER APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING ZAPATA COUNTY JUDGE TO
EXECUTE TRANSFER OF 283.75 ACRE FEET PER ANNUM OF CLASS A
MUNICIPAL RIGHTS IN THE WATERS OF RIO GRANDE RIVER FROM ZAPATA
COUNTY TO ZAPATA COUNTY WATER WORKS**

Motion was made by Commissioner Martinez, seconded by Commissioner Vela, to approve and authorize the Zapata County Judge to execute the transfer of 283.75 acre feet per annum of Class A municipal rights in the waters of the Rio Grande River from Zapata County to the Zapata County Waterworks. The water rights should have been transferred from the San Ygnacio Municipal Utility District to the Zapata County Waterworks, but were erroneously transferred to Zapata County as requested by Honorable Joseph Rathmell, County Judge.

The above motion, being put to a vote, was approved by the affirmative vote of all members of the Court.
