

2013 Property Tax Rates in Zapata County

This notice concerns 2013 property tax rates for Zapata County. It presents information about three tax rates. Last year's tax rate is the actual rate the taxing unit used to determine property taxes last year. This year's *effective* tax rate would impose the same total taxes as last year if you compare properties taxed in both years. This year's *rollback* tax rate is the highest tax rate the taxing unit can set before taxpayers can start tax rollback procedures. In each case these rates are found by dividing the total amount of taxes by the tax base (the total value of taxable property) with adjustments as required by state law. The rates are given per \$100 of property value.

If Zapata County adopts a 2013 tax rate equal to the effective tax rate of 1.029699 per \$100 of value, taxes would increase compared to 2012 taxes by \$ 24,314.

Schedule D - State Criminal Justice Mandate (For Counties)

The Zapata County County Auditor certifies that Zapata County County has spent \$ 0 in the previous 12 months beginning 10/01/2012, for the maintenance and operations cost of keeping inmates sentenced to the Texas Department of Criminal Justice. Schedule F - Enhanced Indigent Health Care Expenditures
